A revitalized worship space for all services

Our sanctuary has needed a facelift for some time. The planned improvements will create an environment for dynamic and inspiring worship for all generations.

A new children's wing

Children are our future! An exciting and modern ministry space for children will attract new families to our church and bring them back week-after-week. Children will be enthused about this space and parents will feel safer and more secure about its location near the sanctuary.

A new gathering space for expanded hospitality and personal connections

To end relational poverty, we must have facilities that help connect us to others in a relaxed and engaging setting. An enlarged space outside the sanctuary will help bring people together to enjoy fellowship and build relationships that reflect the love of Jesus.

An infrastructure that allows us extended use of our facilities and utilities

We have not done any significant work on the basic needs of our building for many years. There are numerous core improvements that, left undone in the future, will render the structure unsafe and below building code standards. Infrastructure improvements such as upgrading HVAC systems, sprinklers and installing an elevator are crucial enhancements to care for our members, reach our community and fulfill our mission.
